ABOUT THE PROJECT

- 408 beds across 18 storeys
- Demolition of existing above ground structures and limited excavation to form lift pit, onsite detention tank and substation.
- Construction of an 18 storey (plus rooftop plant) building comprising podium (level 2) and tower (18 levels) elements
- Precast brick facade at various locations to enhance the Community Streetscape
- 2x small retail units at ground floor on Regent Street
- Remainder of the building to be used for student accommodation, including
 - 408 single and double occupancy rooms
 - Student communal facilities including lounge areas, quiet and study areas, communal kitchens and dining areas, bicycle storage, cinema and communal outdoor spaces

- Structure Complete - August 2024
- Roofing, Cladding, Façade Finishes Complete - September 2024
- Fit-out Complete - November 2024
- Project completion - November 2024

- Façade installation completed to level 7
- Fit out works underway
- Workers have been strictly advised to not park in regent street to allow more space for residents and customers.
- Footpath restrictions have been lifted alongside regent street.

PROJECT FACTS



- The site is located directly above the Sydney Metro line.
- The project will have approximately 3,880m³ of concrete poured and 2200t of reinforcement.
- This project can accommodate 408 residents
- The mural designed by a Local indigenous artist will be installed on precast panel from level 11-15. This will be a major feature of the project allowing for a connection within the community.
